Piano Lesson Policies 2024/25

Payment Policy & Schedule

30 minute weekly lessons = \$298 monthly

45 minute weekly lessons = \$447 monthly

60 minute weekly lessons = \$596 monthly

I offer lessons 40 weeks through the school year from Sunday, Sept.1st – Thursday, June 26th.

During this timeframe, there are 3 weeks off built in - 2 for winter break (December 22nd - January 2nd) and 1 for spring break (March 9th - 13th).

You will receive an invoice 7 days before the first of every month with the amount due which is payable by e-transfer to lizcraig17@gmail.com. The due date for each invoice is the first of the month. A late fee of \$30 will apply if the invoice is not received by the 7th of the month. Payments made by PayPal will be subject to a 4% fee.

In the months of July and August 2025, lessons will be scheduled and billed individually at the rate of \$149 per 60 minute session. Lessons in July & August are not guaranteed but I do strive to offer up to 4 lessons per month to keep momentum going.

Included in the monthly fee is:

-weekly one on one lessons as per the schedule described above

-a highly personalized lesson plan and practice notes

-access to all content on the Piano Maestro app (\$10/month value)

-access to all **non-competitive*** performance opportunities (workshops, recitals, etc.) run by ORMTA Central Toronto Branch as well as organized by myself

-all sheet music, books and materials

*Competitive recitals/festivals and exams will be an extra fee and are completely optional.

Scholarships offered by ORMTA Central Toronto Branch can be a great incentive for these opportunities!

High school credits are offered by Ontario for Level 7 & 8 exam completion.

Student Cancellations/Makeup Lesson Policy

Please cancel your lesson as soon as you know you can't make it in the student portal (<u>https://www.mymusicstaff.com/</u>) so that another student can book the open slot. Less than 48 hours notice will result in no makeup given. **Makeups for student cancellations are not guaranteed.** You can look through the calendar and book in an open slot to reschedule your lesson if it is before the 48 hour deadline.

All makeups for student cancellations must be completed prior to June 26th, 2025 and will not be made up in the summer months (July & August 2025).

Teacher Cancellations/Lateness

If I need to cancel for any reason, I will add a makeup credit to your account. These credits can be used to book extra lessons during the school year or during the summer and will expire on September 1, 2025. If there is very bad weather and it is unsafe for me to drive over, I will offer an online lesson instead.

I strive to build in enough time between students to drive and arrive on time, however sometimes heavy traffic can make me late. If I arrive late, I will always stay and teach the full amount of lesson time booked.
